1. To apply for a camping permit, please complete the enclosed application and return to:

2. Upon receipt of your application, your requests will be reviewed and logged. Payments from foreign countries cannot be made by mail, due to the problem with American currency. Therefore the following options may be taken to obtain camping permits:
 - a. If your time of arrival is between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except holidays; your permit can be obtained at our office. Refer to above address.
 - b. If your time of arrival is after our regular office hours, weekends and holidays; your permit can be obtained from the Park Ranger at the camp site, provided the following stipulations are made.
 - This application must be filled out completely and mailed back at least one month prior to first camp date.
 - Parks Permit Section will stamp your application "APPROVED" and mail it back to you. You must have this application with you at the camp site when the Park Ranger does his rounds. The Park Ranger will issue your permit to you for \$3.00 per night per adult. The total amount due on your permit will be verified by the Parks Permit Section and written in on your permit application. You must have the exact amount, in U.S. Dollars, ready for payment.
3. We accept reservations for large eleemosynary groups registered with the State of Hawaii (i.e., Scouts, Sierra Groups, etc.). Please submit proof of registration when you apply for a permit.
